New Braunfels city leadership needs to realize how massively popular Pickleball has become in our region and how poorly the city is supporting it. To start, public tennis courts should have pickleball lines painted on them. Now to play outdoor pickleball outdoors on public courts, NB players must go to San Marcos, Canyon Lake, San Antonio or Austin. Second, NB should allocate capital funds to build dedicated outdoor pickleball courts. Many cities are doing this to attract people to move into their communities. Next, the NB's public indoor courts at Das Rec and Westside are not managed well. Basically during operating hours for these courts, all skill levels are mixed together so beginners often have to play against top players and top players must play with people much below them in skill level. Rather than have all courts dedicated to all levels of play, certain courts should be designated for different skill levels. Courts designated for beginners should have city staff or community volunteers available to teach the rules and techniques for playing. Also, there are many people that would like to be able to reserve a court so they can play with selected other players. The city should have a scheduling system to allow people to reserve courts. Finally, the city should have a pickleball knowledgeable person on site during pickleball hours. This person could rate players and recommend which skill levels they play in. This person could also dynamically allocate which courts are used for each skill level depending on the skills of people in attendance. There are many avid pickleball players who would volunteer to help the city to design these new programs and facilities and to staff the sessions as described above. The city should consider establishing an ongoing committee of community volunteers and city employees. This group could brainstorm to figure it how to implement the best practices described above and organize volunteers to work during the PB sessions. Right now, because the pickleball outdoor facilities are lacking and indoor courts are not managed well, many players go to other cities to play. Hopefully NB will be able to capitalize on this opportunity to expand and improve utilization of their pickleball facilities and programs.

THE CITY NEEDS TO INVEST IN multiple projects. As a geographer and as a resident, there are numerous issues throughout the city that if left uninvested and unattended to, the city will crumble under the influx of new residents.

- 1) The roads need to be widened and in many places there needs to be an addition of another lane, or turn lanes (e.g., Saur Lane and 758, Barbarosa and 1101, and basically all of Barbarosa from Alves to 1101).
- 2) The intersection at 46 and Saengerhalle is a death trap. Coming from either direction, to get in the turn lane it slows down traffic and the turn lane is so short due to the unbalanced nature of that intersection (46, Mary Blvd, Saengerhalle) and the poles in the road. There needs to be a better way.
- 3) There is an unnecessary amount of cement that is used to force flow of traffic. For example in Creekside there are three turn lanes (the new one for what was supposed to be a grocery store, one right before Home Goods, and the one into Specs) all separated and spaced apart with cement in between. And then the parking lots don't even connect so if you make a wrong turn because the whole thing is confusing to begin with you have to turn around.
- 4) Why can't we connect businesses together rather than every single one have their own driveway and forcing people onto 46. It is just insane!
- 5) We need to maintain and protect GREEN SPACES. With all of the development and houses, we have lost a HUGE amount of green spaces which is important to keep from a rising urban heat index. What that means is that New Braunfels is going to get significantly hotter in temperature because the buildings are retaining the heat and locking it into our atmosphere, whereas with green spaces it can reflect back out.
- 6) Parking downtown needs to be essential. New Braunfels is NOT a pedestrian/bike/public transit city, and it never will be one. This is not Austin, it is not San Antonio. Therefore, free parking in the downtown area, such as parking garages should be considered.
- 7) 46 is all around horrendous coming from Seguin into town. It should not take 30 minutes to get from Pieper Road to the downtown area and this is during ALL hours of the day, Sunday through Saturday. The number of cars are just getting worse because you boast about how you approved 12,000 building permits in the last 10 years. Do you guys not live in town? The trucks add to the traffic coming from Seguin (I-10) to I-35. There needs to be a different route for them. Not to mention we only have 46 or 306
