

Overview

The monthly financial report is directed at providing a snapshot of the General Fund revenues and expenditures, as well as other important financial information, through the month of **May**, with 66.7% of the fiscal year complete. At the end of May, 64.8% of total payroll for the fiscal year has elapsed and is reflected in the Employee Expenses category of each fund. This report also includes a Vacant Positions Summary as of 6/30/2024, an Economic Data Report, and a report reflecting Roadway Impact Fees and Park Development Fee balances by district.

In the financial graphs, the General Fund revenues are consolidated into major revenue sources such as Property, Sales, and Other Taxes including Franchise Fees. All other General Fund revenue is consolidated for reporting purposes. General Fund expenditures are shown by department and by category.








Roadway Impact Fees - Balances Inception to Date



Park Development Fees


Park Development Fees - Balances Inception to Date



Economic Data Fiscal YTD 2024 – May




- May 2024 gross sales tax revenue was down 1.1% compared to May 2023. Gross sales tax revenue fiscal year to date through May was up 5.5% compared to FY 2023. May's gross sales tax revenue includes any audit adjustments made at the State Comptroller's Office.
- May 2024 current period collections, which do not include audit adjustments, decreased 2.8% compared to May 2023 and was up 3.4% YTD compared to FY 2023.

Hotel Occupancy Tax Collection FY 2024 - May




- May collections trended up this month compared to May 2023, increasing 12.2%.
